The ConserFund Loan program was established by the South Carolina Energy Office to assist government and non-profit entities in carrying out energy efficiency projects.

Donaldson Center Greenville, SC

Originally established as an Air Force base during World War II, Donaldson Center is now an industrial park housing Lockheed Martin who refurbishes and upgrades military aircraft.

THE RESULTS

Replacement of furnaces and insulation of hangers
Donaldson Center was able to finance a \$1,929,000 loan through the ConserFund program. The loan allowed them to replace oil-fired furnaces with new high-efficiency gas furnaces in nine of the buildings on site and re-clad and insulate ten hangars. They estimate an annual savings of \$143,626 per year and provided job security for over 1,200 employees.
